Weather maps have been looked at and studied and the results are Sunny with possibilities of rain and wind at times with calm to rough seas.. That should cover it all.

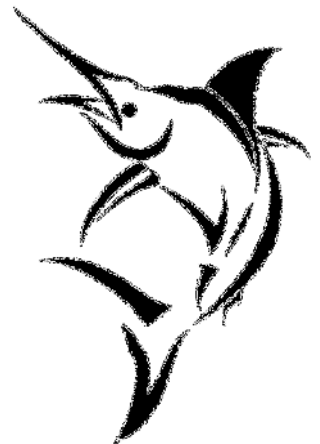
### OUTLOOK AS OF 29/02
